THE STATE LIBRARY OF SOUTH AUSTRALIA BRINGS CHRISTMAS MAGIC TO THE MORTLOCK

The State Library of South Australia is inviting Christmas lovers to experience some festive season magic in the iconic Mortlock Chamber these holidays, with an exclusive display from the National Pharmacies Christmas Pageant, Adelaide's largest indoor Christmas Tree and a range of free Christmas activities and events from Saturday 23 November.

The special display of treasures from the National Pharmacies Christmas Pageant is filled with nostalgia, joy and wonder. Featured pieces include Kingsley Vintage Cars, character heads such as Seven Dwarfs and Teddy Bears Picnic, Humpty Dumpty and PS Murray Explorer float model and costumes, and Pageant clown costumes, thrones and a fairy bench from the John Martin's Magic Cave, and the 2024 mini float competition winner 'Bee Merry'.

State Library of South Australia Director, Megan Berghuis, is looking forward to embracing the season, and making the display of treasures from the National Pharmacies Christmas Pageant available for the public to view up close.

"It has been magical watching this nostalgic collection of treasures come together in our gorgeous Mortlock Chamber. As the custodian of the state's stories, we feel proud to display these pieces that bring back such wonderful Christmas memories.

"We look forward to having generations of Christmas lovers visit us to experience the display, take in our beautiful 7-metre-high Christmas tree, which also offers a gorgeous photo backdrop, and enjoy free seasonal crafts, activities and entertainment."

The State Library of South Australia's 7-metre-high Christmas tree is powered by SA Power Networks and has been displayed in the Mortlock Chamber each year since 2020. It reaches to the second level of the Mortlock Chamber and is adorned with hundreds of twinkling lights and dazzling decorations.

The giant Christmas Tree will be unveiled at a free ticketed sneak peek event from 10am on Saturday 23 November and will then form the centrepiece for a variety of free Christmas activities for families. Activities will be daily from 23 November and include a craft and making space, writing postcards to Father Christmas, story time sessions, a reading nook and live choirs.

Visitors to the Library will also be greeted by 'Santa the Curator', a giant inflatable Santa displayed in the Library's forecourt as part of the City of Adelaide's Christmas Trail. The trail encourages people to follow a city-wide 'Santa Course' map and visit all 10 Santas around Adelaide.
